Wardens' Corner

ROOFTOP HEATING UNIT

As you are aware, last summer we purchased a replacement rooftop heating unit that services Soward Hall, the Nursery, the kitchen and adjacent areas. It was installed in mid October and we experienced multiple service issues with it and the unit proved to be totally unreliable. During this period, our vendor worked tirelessly to remediate the many problems, including bringing in the experts from the manufacturer. But the issues were never resolved.

In January, we had an in-person meeting with our contractor and he was asked to replace this unit at no cost to us. He agreed to our request and on March 22nd, a replacement from a different manufacturer was installed. Since then, it has been working fine with no hiccups. We are monitoring the system to ensure that it continues to operate smoothly. We now have remote access to our two thermostats and we can tell if the system is running efficiently, can schedule times for the heat, can view the temperatures in Soward Hall and the Nursery and can raise and lower them as needed.

We thank you for your patience as we worked through the issues with our contractor.

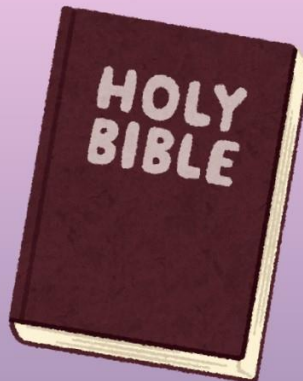




The next Men's Fellowship Breakfast will be on **Saturday, April 13th at 9:00am.**
