From the Incumbent

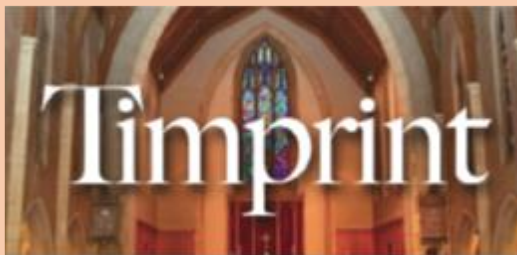
