DO YOU HAVE GENTLY-USED TECH THAT A REFUGEE FAMILY CAN USE?

Two weeks ago, we received a message from AURA, the Anglican United Refugee Alliance. This is the same group that we worked with when we sponsored a refugee family in 2016.

AURA asked us if we could provide specific assistance for an Afghani refugee family who arrived in Canada in May of this year. This is a family of seven with two parents and five children ages 9 to 24. Sadly, the father has kidney failure and is quite unwell. The plan had been for him to work. He is an experienced painter, and the sponsors had a job lined up for him which he is now unable to do. The adult children are looking for employment but have so far been unsuccessful.

AURA has asked if we could help the family in these specific ways:

1. Provide several used but functional cell phones (preferable less than 5 years old)
2. Provide several used but functional laptops and/or iPad or Android tablets (preferably less than 5 years old)
3. Donation of funds for dental root canal work for three family members. Unfortunately, this dental work is expensive and is not funded by the Federal Government's dental plan for refugees.

Through word of mouth, we have already collected some cell phones. If you have a laptop, an iPad or an Android tablet in a closet somewhere that is no longer in use but fully functional, please consider donating it to this family. Phones, laptops and tablets will be wiped clean by the IT staff at AURA. These items can be dropped off at the office or by contacting Michael Clarke at 647-389-3523 and arrangements can be made to pick them up. If we collect more items than we've been asked for, we will turn them over to AURA for use by other refugee families.

The root canal work that is required by the family is urgent. If it is within your means to make a donation for this dental work, please send an e-transfer to the church office at office@sttimothy.ca with the notation "Family". Tax receipts will be issued for the cash donations. Tax receipts are also under consideration for laptop, tablet and phone donations.

Our parish was very supportive of our sponsored refugee family and we hope that you can assist again in some way for this worthy cause.
