

#### The Mishamikoweesh Water Partnership

World leaders agreed that Access to Clean Water and Sanitation is a central priority in their 2015 Sustainable Development Goals. But many Canadians don't have access to clean running water, and that reality is racialized, predominantly affecting Indigenous people.

For thirteen years, a network of concerned Anglicans (and friends!) have been partnering with First Nation Communities in securing clean, running water in Indigenous homes across Canada. Lack of clean, running water impacts physical and mental health, hygiene and access to education.
