From the Incumbent

This Sunday, we will celebrate our patronal feast and reflect on our parish namesake, St. Timothy (feast day: January 26). My understanding of why our parish was named after him is that he was a protégé of St. Paul, and our parish was a church plant supported in part by St. Paul's on Bloor, where our first rector, Henry Marsh, had served as a curate. After 32 years (!) of ministry at St. Tim's, the Rev. Marsh became the Bishop of Yukon, where he served for five years, and the rest, as we say, is history.
